This is a complimentary, unpaid appointment and will be for the second year of your initial three-year appointment which began in August 2016. This appointment is conditional on issue of a J-1 visa for scholars on an annual basis.

U.S. immigration law requires that every J-1 scholar and J-2 family member have adequate health insurance coverage for the duration of their stay in the United States. The University of Iowa requires this insurance to be purchased through the University of Iowa, and you will sign up for this insurance during the J-1 scholar check-in (http://international.uiowa.edu/isss/new/pre-arrival/health-insurance). 
